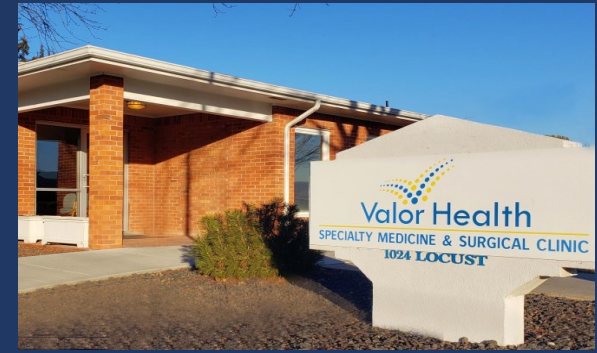




Valor Health
