

Valor Health Board of Directors Seeks New Board Member

Valor Health is a county owned facility governed by the Hospital Board of Trustees who are appointed by the Board of Gem County Commissioners (the “County Board”). The Hospital Board and Commissioners are seeking a new Hospital Board member to replace a retiring member. The Hospital Board is charged with the care, custody, upkeep, management and operation of all property belonging to the county and devoted to hospital purposes. The Hospital Board is responsible for all money received by the hospital, must provide monthly financial reports to the County Board and must publish an annual financial statement reflecting financial operations of the hospital. The Hospital Board exists to promote the health of the citizens of the community through the operations of Valor Health.

Hospital Board members are citizens of Gem County who have the willingness, ability, circumstances, and moral character to fulfill the duties, and are sufficiently free from any conflicts of interest that could impede, impair, or interfere with the Board member’s ability to effectively fulfill the duties. Board members serve three-year terms and are eligible for reappointment after successfully completing their term. The present opening is the result of a member who has completed their term and desires to retire.
